52 – Library Closures

At the last meeting there was some uncertainty around the legal challenge of the Deri library closure. Cllr R Chapman clarified an appeal is in progress; and the library remains open. However, there are staffing shortages caused by staff moving to other roles.

93 – Review of 2026 Christmas events

Christmas Activities 2026 – Early Booking

94 – Precept Decision 2026-27

Increase from £17,000 → £20,000 confirmed and submitted before deadline.

Justification includes rising NI costs and summer scheme expenses.

96 – CCTV in Deri

Mobile CCTV unit will be installed on the lamppost linked to Christmas lights.

This is a temporary, moveable camera but expected to help with recent vehicle crime.

97 - Storage of Darran Valley Community Council files at Parc Cwm Darran

Council must vacate storage at Parc Cwm Darran.

County council unable to provide archive space.

New storage agreed: Flying Start office, Fochriw.

Volume: 4 full filing cabinets (plus older material).

105 - Darran Valley Community Council Crime Update

Crime Figures

- **December:** 3 crimes
- **January:** 14 crimes
- **Increase:** +11 crimes
- Surge mainly due to **vehicle break-ins and door-checking incidents.**

Other Notes:

- Anti-social behaviour: none recorded.
- Police engaged with Fochriw Tots Playgroup on crime prevention.
- Further vehicle incidents in Darran likely to appear in next month's report as some residents did not formally report all damage.
